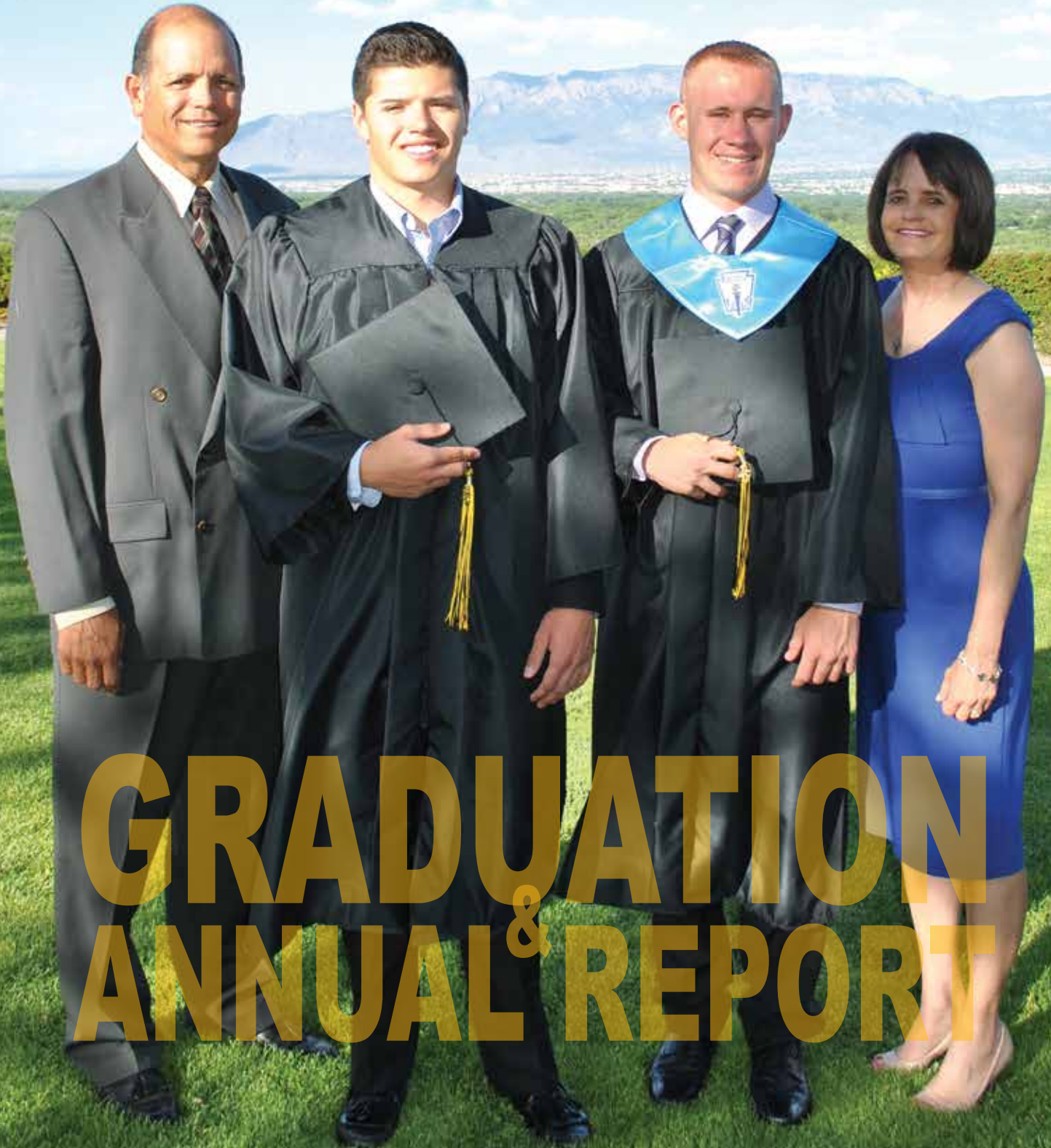

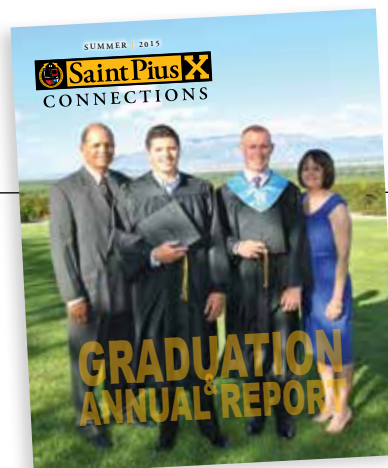

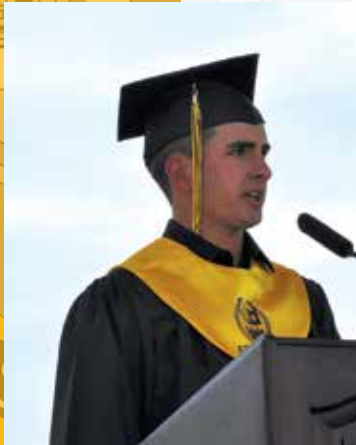

Pitcher is Player of the Year

SPX pitcher **Mitch DiLorenzo**, who threw a perfect game against Gallup, earned District Player of the Year honors. Named First Team All-District were **DiLorenzo, Mason Martinez, Miles Hilton** and **Mitch Buffet**. Hilton threw a no-hitter against Highland. SPX Baseball went 15-11, 7-2 in District. The team lost to Centennial in the first round of the state playoffs.

Water Polo Championship

The SPX girls water polo team earned its first state championship in 2015 and went 5-1 in the regular season. The team dominated the state tournament, beating Cibola 18-5, Albuquerque High 5-0, Eldorado 10-5, and Volcano Vista 13-8. The boys water polo team went 5-2 in the regular season and finished fourth in state competition, being knocked out of the championships by eventual winner Albuquerque High. Goaltender **Noah Howard** was selected second team All-State.

Golf State Success

The boys varsity golf team brought home the State Runner-Up trophy for the second year in a row. The Sartans were led by junior captain **Patrick McCarthy** who finished in third place overall and earned All-State Honors. The team also won the district title and **Tyrone Thomas, Christian Hess, Patrick McCarthy** and **Elijah Wyckoff** were named All-District golfers. On the girls side freshman sensation **Ashlee Garrett** finished second in the State Tournament, trailing the winner by only three strokes. She earned All-State honors with this performance.

Girls Tennis 9-1

The SPX girls tennis team put up an overall season record of 9-1, losing to Farmington in the quarterfinals of the team state championships. At the 5A District 5 Individual Tournament **Bianca Baca** and **Skyler Valdez** placed second in doubles. **Gabby Rivera** placed second in singles and **Karina Scheller** placed third. The boys tennis team placed third in district.

Rugby Finishes Fifth

The St Pius rugby team went 8-7-1 and finished fifth in the state among 16 teams. Top try scorer for the season was first year player **Luke McConnell**. Senior leadership was provided by **Parker Padilla** and **Jonah Griego**.

Track Champions

In girls track, freshman **Arianna Martinez** was the state champion in the high jump, tying the SPX school record at 5' 4" this season. Junior **Steven Duran** (800m) and senior **Elias Limon** (triple jump) were boys state champions this year. Limon was SPX's high point man, placing in the triple jump, long jump, 100m, 200m and anchoring the 4x400 relay. Senior **Patience Kennedy** (100m, 200m, 400m, 4x100) and sophomore **Jordyn DiLorenzo** (800m, 1600m, 3200m) were high point athletes for the Lady Sartans. The SPX boys track team earned the State Runner-Up title, their highest state meet finish in school history. The girls placed fourth at the state meet and won their ninth straight district title. The boys placed second at district.

SPX Softball Undefeated in District

SPX softball went undefeated in district play in 2015. **Justyce Millan** received district Player of the Year honors. Named First Team All-District were **Gaby Mora, Krysta Lucero, Domonique Sandoval** and **Juliet Kelly**. Second Team honorees are **Alejandra DeLaCruz** and **Kasey Givens**. The team lost to Piedra Vista in the first round of the state playoffs.

ACADEMICS

The Class of 2015 included a National Merit Finalist, a National Merit Semifinalist, six National Hispanic Scholars and a Gates Millennium Scholar. The class contributed 14,000 hours of service to the community and received offers of \$10 million in scholarships.

The 2015 Saint Pius X Academic Decathlon Team earned its 14th State Championship over 17 years of competition and placed fourth in the nation at the National Finals in Garden Grove, Calif. Senior Christian Lucero earned a national gold medal in the speech category, a scholarship for his overall score and a scholarship for being voted the team Most Valuable Player by his team. He also achieved the highest individual score among all students at the state competition.

Brooke Landavazo, SPX chemistry and anatomy teacher, was recognized as an outstanding teacher and received an award of \$250 at the Central New Mexico Science and Engineering Research Challenge.

The SPX Robotix Team Gold competed at the VEX Robotics World Championships in April after being named the state Tournament Champions and earning the Design Award at the New Mexico State University VEX Robotics Event in February. The school's two teams earned first and second places at the regional VEX Robotics competition at UNM.

St. Pius X students excelled in the 2015 National French Contest. Sophomore Xavier Robinson is State Champion in French level II and ranked ninth in the nation. Senior Joe Couls placed second in the state and ranked ninth in the nation, competing at French level III. Siblings Max Gervais (senior) and Sam Gervais (freshman) placed respectively second and third in the state in French level I and ranked ninth and tenth in the nation.

At the Central New Mexico Science and Engineering Research Challenge held at UNM in March, 13 students received recognition for Special Awards and Top of Category awards and earned prizes totaling more than \$1,500. Harold Gridley, Samantha Multari, Mark Perea and Andy Sinclair qualified for the state competition, where Multari and Perea received Honorable Mention Awards.

New for 2015-2016 is an exciting course in robotics. Students will build robots and be exposed to programming, computer-aided design and 3-D printing.

ACTIVITIES

Sartan musician **Timothy Tran** earned All State honors as first oboe in Symphonic Orchestra, which ranks him the top oboist in the state. Also honored were **Devon Poage**, **Mateo Gutierrez** and **Kulani Gonzales-Stocks**.

Sartan singers earning All State honors were **Isabella Bruzzese**, **Kailynn Castillo**, **Julia Gallegos** and **Xavier Robinson** in the Mixed Choir, and **Veronica Baca** and **Kelly Cox** in the Treble Choir.

In state DECA competition, **Carisse Enriquez** placed third in accessories marketing, qualified for national competition, and received a \$500 scholarship from Johnson and Wales. A total of nine DECA students placed in their categories at the state event.

Drama students **Shamus Gridley**, **Veronica Baca**, **Jessica King** and **Amelia Mascolo** qualified to represent SPX at Thespian Festival 2015, a national competition held in June. Theater students presented *The Curious Savage* in November and *Godspell* in April.



Members of the SPX Sports Medicine Program excelled at the 2015 NMAA Athletic Training Challenge held in Las Cruces. Sartan **Emily Dieterichs** earned the highest individual score with a 177 out of 200, competing against 90 other students. In the relay events, **Elena Garcia** won a gold medal, **Noah Bruick** earned silver and **Kelsy Owens** and **Zane Van Winkle** won bronze. The team, comprised of 16 students, finished fourth in the team event.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

MAD Against Hunger, a yearly effort by St. Pius students to provide food to hungry people in New Mexico and around the world, packed 194,000 meals this year. MAD Against Hunger with the help of the Parochial Schools of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe have packaged about 1.5 million meals over the past seven years.

The SPX Community Outreach Club sold almost 1,400 carnations the week of Valentine's Day -- enough to pay tuition for five students at St. Pius's sister school in Puno, Peru.

St. Pius X High School raised a record \$4,274 in January for Make-A-Wish New Mexico to help grant a 4-year-old's wish to

visit Disney World. The amount raised was almost double raised by any other school in Albuquerque for the program.

ATHLETICS



The top-seeded Sartan girls soccer team earned its second-straight state championship in a final game match up between SPX and rival Albuquerque Academy. The Class 5A championship game ended in a 2-1 Sartan victory. Head Coach David Sullivan Sr., retiring this year after 21 seasons, was named Class 5A Coach of the Year.

Junior **Steven Duran** (800m) and senior **Elias Limon** (triple jump) were state champions. The SPX boys track team earned the State Runner-Up title, their highest state meet finish in school history.

The boys varsity golf team brought home the State Runner-Up trophy for the second year in a row.

SPX, through the work of athletic trainer Juanita Marquez, was one of only six schools in the state to earn Safe Sports School First Team status for its efforts to make sure student-athletes train, compete and are evaluated in the safest manner possible.
